Hard chrome plated barsteel from stainless steel

AISI 329

Material AISI 329 (duplex) is a austenetic-ferritic stainless that has a much better corrosion-resistance in comparising with AISI 431. AISI 329 has, compared to AISI 316, a much better resistance against tension-corrosion and much better mechanical properties.

General

Hard chrome plated barsteel from stainless steel AISI 329 (materialnumber 1.4460).

The bars are ready to use and have a diameter tolerance of f7.

The chrome layer thickness has minimum 20 µm.

The surface roughness (Ra) is maximum 0,2 µm (cut-off 0,8 mm).

The surface hardness in minimum 900 HV.

The hard chrome plated bars will be mainly used as pistonrods for hydraulic cylinders.

Out of roundness

Maximum 1/2 of the diameter tolerance.

Straightness

For diameters ≥ 30 mm: maximum deviation of 0,2 mm per 1000 mm
(< 30 mm: 0,3 per 1000 mm).

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
